

WHNC Membership

The Whitehawk Neighborhood Committee (WHNC) was officially formed in July 2008. We are not a Homeowners Association. The committee is a Non-Profit Corporation organized for "pleasure, recreation, and fun-filled social events." Membership in the committee is voluntary and open to all homeowners in the Whitehawk Neighborhood. The membership fee of \$10 per household is used for community events. Membership is not a requirement for participation in WHNC events. All residents of Whitehawk are welcome to participate in these events, however since we are a Non-Profit Corporation, we rely solely on membership fees and donations to put together these events.

What are my membership fees / donations used for?

All committee members, including the executive board are volunteers and receive no compensation for their time. Membership Fees & Donations given to the WHNC are strictly used to help fund neighborhood events, maintain the website, and pay all necessary filing fees with the State & IRS.

What do I get out of membership?

First and foremost, your membership donation is going to a good cause, it will help the WHNC fund neighborhood events such as the Neighborhood Garage Sale, Camp Out For A Cause, Golf Scramble and more to come!

All neighbors are welcome to attend the annual committee meeting, but only members have voting privileges at these meetings.

Only Members can serve on the Executive Board which is elected annually.

Members are also welcome to attend and provide input at the Executive Board meetings and are welcome to serve on any of the event planning committees.

Members can utilize the "neighbor alerts" email distribution list. The "neighbor alerts" notify the distribution list of any criminal activity in the area, lost pets and other communication that is urgent in nature.

Members will be included in, and receive access to the neighborhood directory. Participation in the neighborhood directory is optional.

Members can post ads, free of charge on the WHNC website.

How do I become a member?

Please fill out the membership form attached below and return it, along with your \$10 membership fee to the address provided on the form. Checks should be made out to the WHNC.

Membership takes effect immediately upon receipt of your registration and expires in June 30, 2010.

How do I make a donation?
